- 17– 1M+3W change places RH | 1W+3M change RH, while{2} 1M+3W dance a Rsh loop; 1M+3W cross back RH while{2} 1W+3M loop | 1W+3M cross back LH, 1W to 2pl while{2} 1M casts to 2pl (2c up)
- **25** 2c+1c R&L

- 17-24 1s set HS, turn 2H & cast down to 3rd place (3s step up 23-24)
- 25-32 2s+3s+1s circle 6H round & back

Repeat, 1s dancing with 3s. Bar 23-24 1s cast 2 places to 4th place, return to own sides at start of new repeat. New top couple cross to 2nd place opp sides bars 31-32

- 1M+2M+3M stand
- the M repeat the W's movements in mirror image 8 bars later, giving RH on [19-20].-On [28] the 9-48 M pass just below their P who is 4 bars into the reel, and face up.

 - **49** Women Circle4 L (at end pull back Rsh to face out); set to and turn P BH.

- 25- All adv {1}, retire {1} | cross LH, to sidelines ; 2c+1c circle4 R

Nathaniel Gow: RSCDS I 2 · Crib: E-cribs

- 9— 1W+2M (NHJ), followed by 1M, dance down the middle; 1W+2M turn inwards and 1M joins (1W hands crossed and joined to outer hands of 1M+2M, their NH making arch above 1W), all three dance up in TRIUMPH to finish 2M in own place and 1c BHJ on opposite sides
- 17– 1c Poussette down the middle to bottom pl (¼ R turn, progress, ¼ turn, ¼ turn, progress, progress with ¼ turn, ½ turn to own side, fall back to sides), (all other couples step up on 23-24).

- **17--** Corners pass and turn (2x,1x,3x)
- **25--** All W set | A&R{2+2} while{6} All M A&R{2+2}; set | All cross RH (2,1,3)

- 17- In lines of 3 down the middle (all swivel R) and up
- 25- 1M followed by 1W dance up, cast round 2W and into 2pl; 1c turn RH
- 33- Circle6 and back
